## NATIONAL PUBLIC AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT CONTESTS

The National Department of Public Affairs invites you to submit your entries for its annual Public Affairs, Publications and Photo contests. *The deadline to submit entries is July 31, 2006.*

**National Public Affairs Awards** will be presented for the best district, division and flotilla projects. There are four basic categories:

1. Use of imagination and creativity
2. Promoting the Auxiliary programs and Auxiliary image
3. Attracting the attention of the media and the boating public
4. Clarity of writing and ease of replication

**National Publication Awards:** Flotilla and division newsletters must be 2005 district award winners. A letter from the DSO-PB must certify that the flotilla and division publications are the district winners. (DSOs-PB may submit their district publication along with the flotilla and division winners.)

**National Photo Awards:** Are you a “shutterbug?” Do you enjoy taking pictures? Here’s your opportunity to submit your best Auxiliary-related photo. *It does not need to have been published.* It may be black and white or color. There are seven categories for judging: Public Affairs, Fellowship, Marine Safety, Member Services, Operations, Public Education and Vessel Safety Checks. Please indicate the category of your submission. Write the identifying information on a label and affix the label to the back of an 8x10 glossy photo.
